



Dear BCS Parents:

Through the years, we have worked on the dress code in order to provide a comfortable, modest fit, and a variety of clothing options. For this upcoming school year, no major changes have been made to the uniform policy. Below is a detailed list of our BCS Uniform Policy for the 2019/20 school year:

Shoes (Boys & Girls) -

Upper school students (Grades 6 -12) will continue to wear boat shoes in tan, brown, navy or gray (no trim). Any brand is acceptable. Students will have to change into athletic shoes for P.E.

Lower school students (Kindergarten - Grade 3) will continue to wear rubber soled athletic shoes in solid white, black, navy or gray with one colored trim (no high tops).

Grades 4 - 5 may wear the rubber soled athletic shoes in solid white, black, navy or gray with one colored trim (no high tops), or they may wear the boat shoes (no trim).

Socks (Boys & Girls) -

All grades must wear socks that are solid white, navy, black or gray (must be plain or Nike symbol only).

Skirts (Girls) -

Skirts for all students, both Upper and Lower School must be knee length, no exceptions.

Lower school students (Kindergarten - Grade 5) may wear Khaki or Navy A-line skirts. *If you have the plaid skirts or skorts purchased prior to this school year, students may wear them if they are the proper length.

Upper school students (Grades 6 -8) will continue to wear the flap skirts. *If you have the plaid pleated skirts or skorts purchased prior to this school year, students may wear them if they are the proper length.

Upper school students (Grades 9 - 12) will continue to wear the box pleat skirts and they must be knee length. *If you have the plaid pleated skirts purchased prior to this school year, students may wear them if they are the proper length.

Shorts (Boys & Girls) -

Lower school students (Kindergarten - Grade 5) may continue to wear navy or khaki shorts or pants.

Upper School students (Grades 6 - 12) may continue to wear khaki shorts or pants. Pants must be purchased at RC Uniform to meet proper criteria and pants must fit loosely.

Shirts (Boys & Girls) -

Both Dry Fit and Polo Shirts are available for all students. Dry fit shirts do not have to be tucked in if they are worn with shorts or pants. Polo shirts must be tucked in, even with shorts and pants, and a belt must be worn. White Oxford Cloth shirts are also available at RC Uniforms.

Polo Dresses (Girls) -

Polo Dresses continue to be available at RC Uniform for Kindergarten - Grade 3.
